At JMU, the libraries are here to support the academic and creative success of all students. The Libraries' knowledgeable staff are eager to help students find what they need. We offer comfortable and safe places to learn, explore and collaborate in **four locations**:

- Rose Library (East Campus) provides five floors of beautifully lit spaces for individual and collaborative study, a café, and a 24-hour study area with a secure entrance and a computer lab. In the makerspace in Rose Library, students can tinker, craft and invent with a wide range of technologies including 3-D printers, virtual reality, sewing machines, and more.
- The Music Library (Main Campus) is in the basement of the Music Building, and its specialized resources, computer lab, printers, and study spaces are open to everyone.
- The Educational Technology Media Center (Memorial Hall) primarily serves the College of Education, but its computer lab, makerspace, printers, and study spaces are open to everyone.
- JMU Libraries Express (Main Campus) is a temporary location near the quad that will offer library services while Carrier Library is under construction.
