TIMELY NOTIFICATION BULLETIN

Possible Threat to the Community

"Your Right to Know"

December 13, 2010

OFFENSE: Indecent Exposure

LOCATION: Outside of the Phillips Center

TIME: Monday, December 13, 2010 at approximately 11:15 AM

SUSPECT: Hispanic Male, described as being of medium build and approximately 5'7" in height, having short black or brown hair, wearing blue jeans, white tennis shoes and a dark blue and black long sleeved jacket.

In compliance with the "Timely Notice" provisions of the federal *Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Crime Statistics Act of 1998* the University Police are giving notice of a reports of indecent exposure on the campus of James Madison University.

Female witnesses reported that a Hispanic male exposed himself to them near the steps outside of the Phillips Center. Suspect was described as having medium dark complexion, approximately 5'7" in height, with short black or brown hair, wearing blue jeans, white tennis shoes and a dark blue and black long sleeved jacket.

The case is still being actively investigated by law enforcement. Members of the University community are urged to be vigilant and report any unusual circumstances and/or suspicious activities/persons.
