- The recent winner of the <u>Society for Neuroscience's Next Generation Award</u> is Associate Professor of Biology <u>Dr. George Vidal</u>. This award is given in recognition of one faculty member's education and outreach efforts to the next generation of neuroscientists. SfN specifically <u>recognized his work</u> directing the <u>JMU Brain Bee</u>, involving undergraduates in his research and outreach, and teaching innovative neuroscience courses to undergraduates. Dr. Vidal was quick to recognize <u>JMU STEM Outreach Center</u> director <u>Dr. Kerry Cresawn</u>, saying the "center's help was indispensable for making the JMU Brain Bee the successful enterprise that it is today."
