Professional Development

JMU Human Resources offers an employee tuition waiver for all eligible employees that are interested in taking academic courses for credit at JMU. Whether you are a degree or non-degree seeking student, you can access and utilize this tuition waiver program at the undergraduate or graduate level. While application fees, books, and any departmental fees are not covered, tuition costs for courses and labs are available to be waived based on employee type:

- Full-time Classified Employees are eligible to receive 2 courses and 1 lab per semester covered after 6 months of employment.
- Wage employees are eligible to receive 1 course and 1 lab covered after 1,000 continuous hours of employment.

Starting Saturday, May 13:


Mon - Thu: 11 a.m. - 9 p.m. Fri: 11 a.m. - 7 p.m.


