Lodging:

We strongly recommend staying at <u>Hotel Madison</u>. It is the most conveniently located option and will allow you to walk easily to the workshop sessions. Its campus location is also a short walk from Historic Downtown's shops and restaurants.

We've arranged for a reserved block of deeply discounted rooms but the discounted rate must be booked before June 19, 2025 and the number of these rooms is limited.

Getting to Harrisonburg:

Driving:

James Madison University is located in Virginia's scenic Shenandoah Valley. Our campus located off I-81 at exit 245 in historic Harrisonburg VA.

Flights

- Dulles International Airport (IAD) in Washington DC is a 2-hour highway drive to Harrisonburg. Dulles offers a wide selection of flights, including direct flights.
- Charlottesville (CHO) is about 1 hour from JMU. It is serviced by Delta, United Express and American Airlines offering over 50 daily non-stop flights to and from Charlotte, Philadelphia, New York/LaGuardia, Washington/Dulles, Atlanta, and Chicago.
- Shenandoah Valley Airport (SHD) is a quick 20-minute drive from JMU. SHD is a small regional airport serviced by American Airlines connecting flights out of Charlotte Douglas Airport in NC. They offer a <u>shuttle service</u> (must be pre-arranged) which may be a good option.
- All three airports offer rental cars..

Getting Around at JMU

Workshop Location:

We will be meeting most days in the Hall of President's dining room which is the second floor of JMU's recently renovated D-Hall (short for Dining Hall). D-Hall is located at in the center of campus. It is a 10-minute walk from Hotel Madison or from visitor parking. Please let us know if you need an accommodation.

Parking:

If you're staying at Hotel Madison, we would recommend that you park in their reserved garage spaces (\$5 per day). Or we can arrange a general campus pass for you.

If you're bringing a car to campus, let us know and we will secure a parking permit for you at no cost. Parking permits will be valid for all of campus for the week. parkingmap.pdf (jmu.edu)
