[Federal Acquisition Regulation: Prohibition on Unmanned Aircraft Systems From Covered Foreign Entities, 89 Federal Register 89464, November 12, 2024](#)

INTERIM RULE: DoD, GSA, and NASA are issuing an interim rule amending the Federal Acquisition Regulation (FAR) to implement a prohibition on the procurement and operation of unmanned aircraft systems manufactured or assembled by an American Security Drone Act-covered foreign entity.

[Federal-State Unemployment Compensation Program: Certifications for 2024 Under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act, 89 Federal Register 90053, November 14, 2024](#)

NOTICE: The Acting Secretary of Labor signed the annual certifications under the Federal Unemployment Tax Act, thereby enabling employers who make contributions to state unemployment funds to obtain certain credits against their liability for the federal unemployment tax. By letter, the certifications were transmitted to the Secretary of the Treasury.

DOI is soliciting public comment on its proposed policy and accompanying award term and condition to ensure government resources are managed with integrity to the greatest public benefit.

[Employment Authorization for Lebanese F-1 Nonimmigrant Students Experiencing Severe Economic Hardship as a Direct Result of the Current Crisis in Lebanon, 89 Federal Register 93634, November 27, 2024](#)

NOTICE: The Department of Homeland Security (DHS) is suspending certain regulatory requirements for F-1 nonimmigrant students from Lebanon who are experiencing severe economic hardship as a direct result of the current crisis in Lebanon. The Secretary is providing relief to these students who are in lawful F-1 nonimmigrant status, so the students may request employment authorization, work an increased number of hours while school is in session, and reduce their course load while continuing to maintain their F-1 nonimmigrant status.
EFFECTIVE DATES: November 27, 2024, and ending on May 27, 2026
