

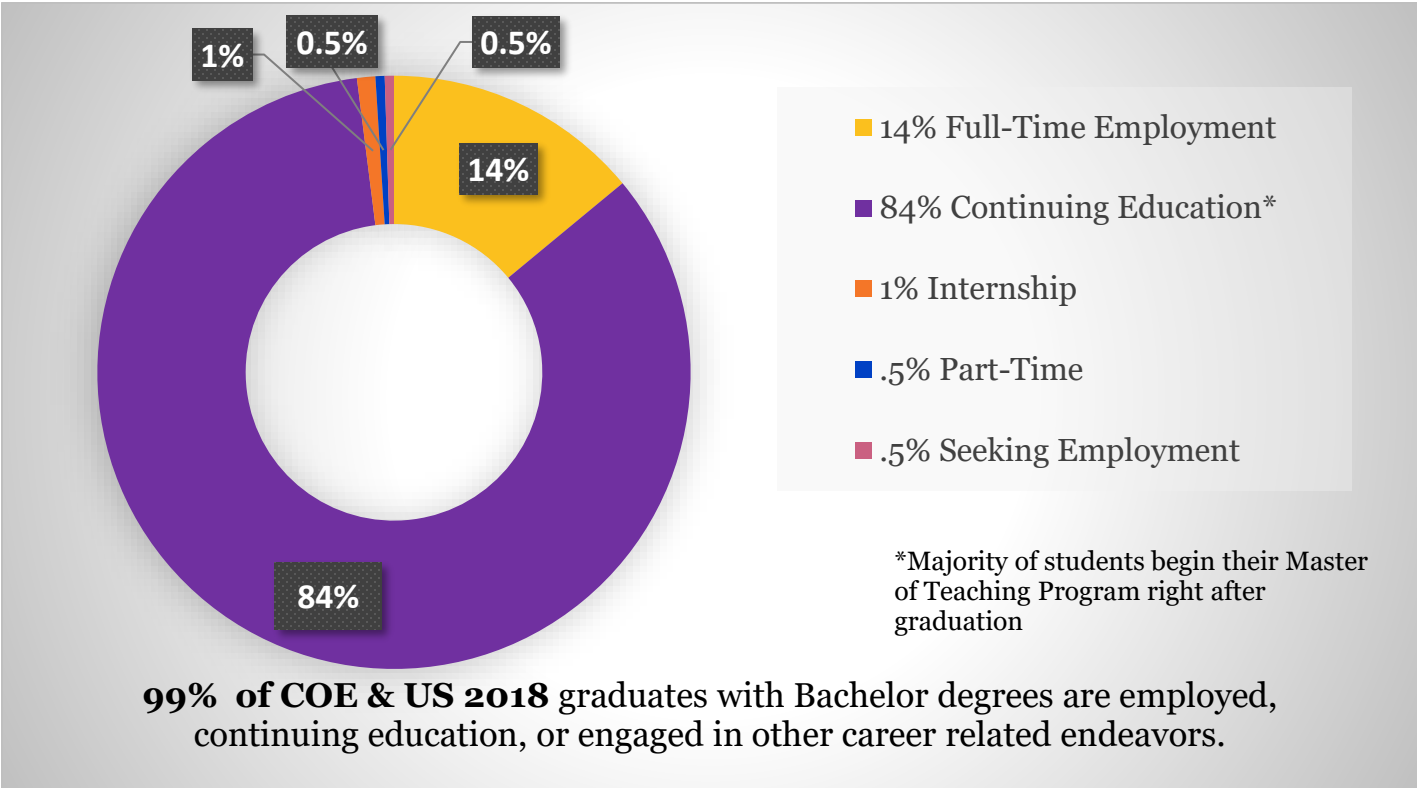


# College of Education & University Studies

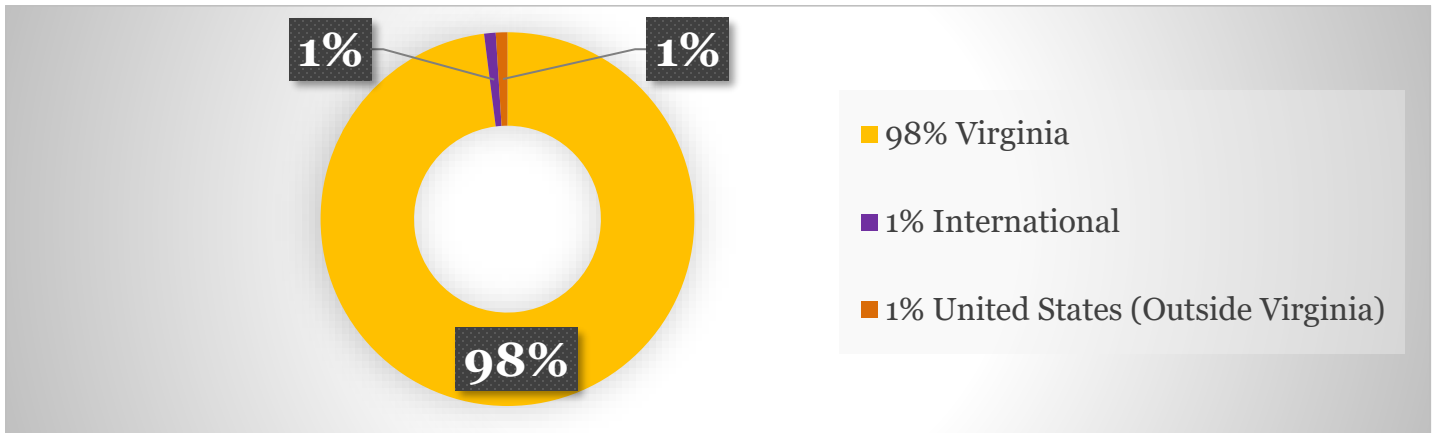
