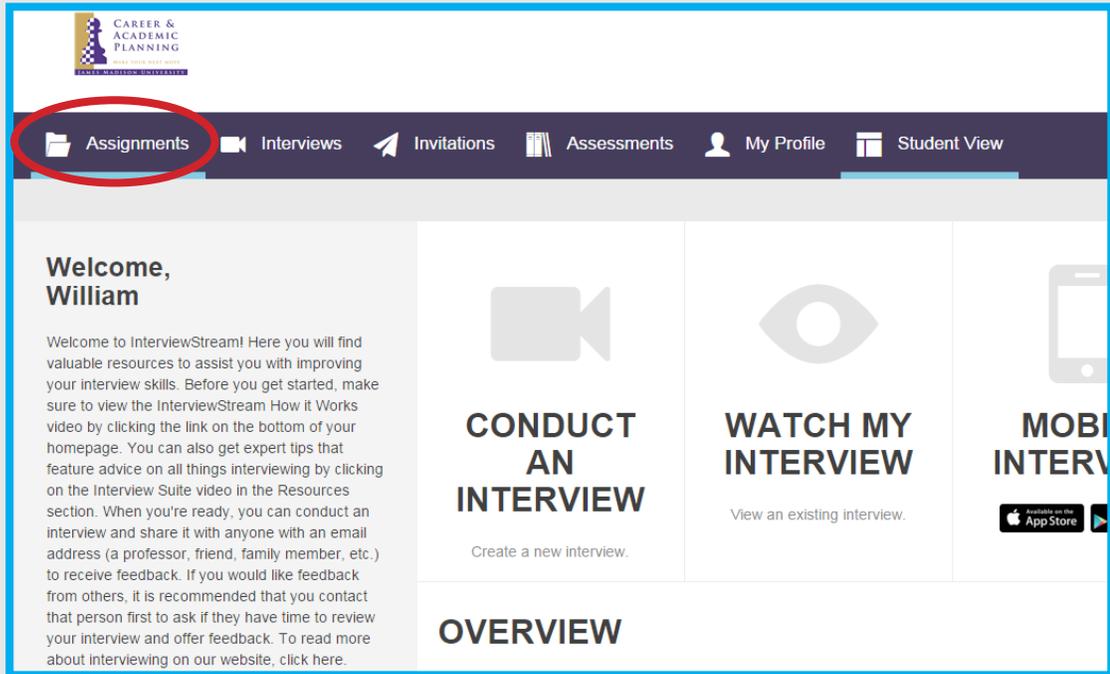


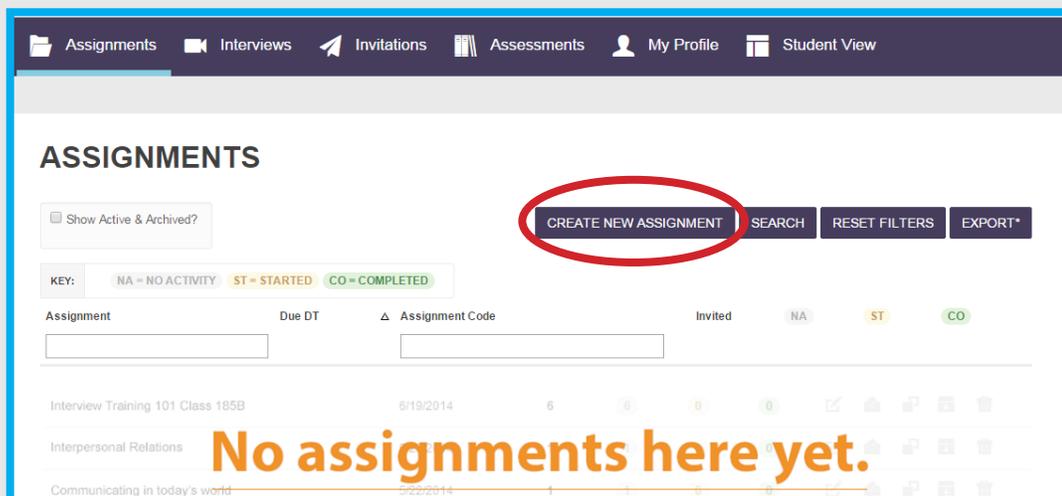

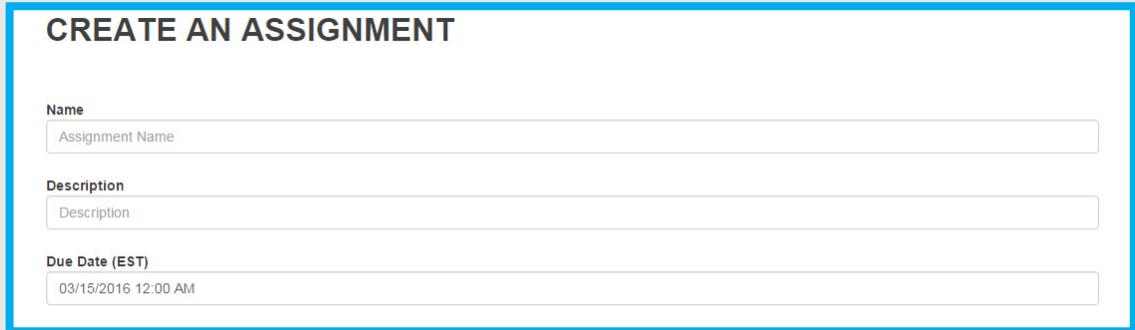
The “Assignments” tab will allow you to see any current or archived assignments that you have created. To make an interview for your class, select the “Create New Assignment” button.

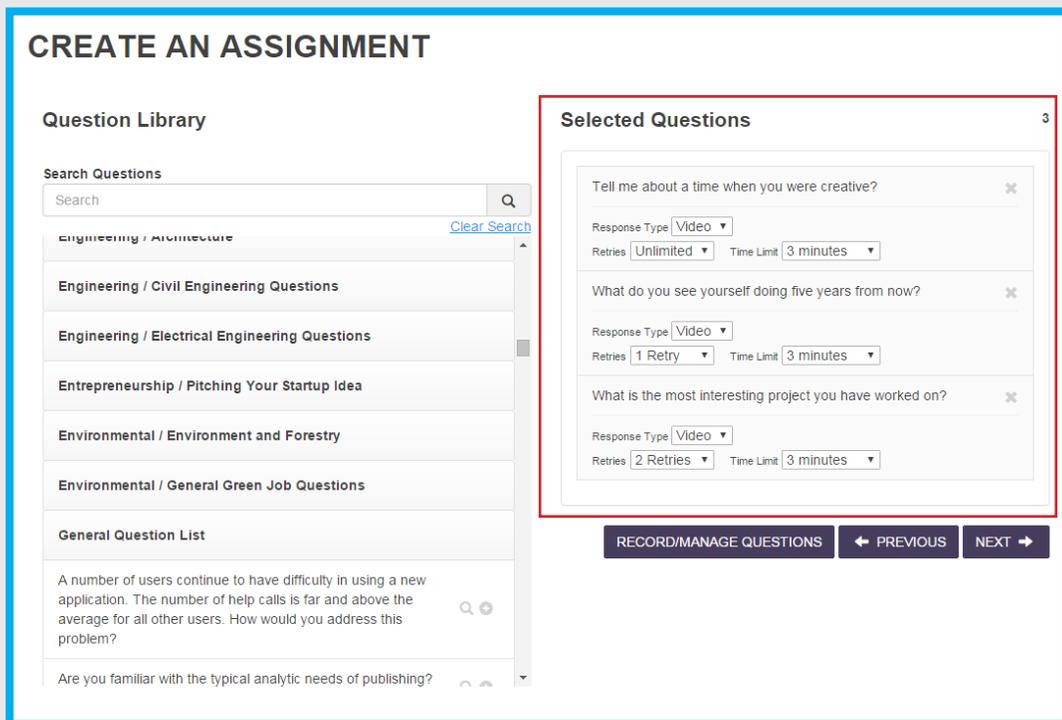

The second page is where you will be able to select interview questions from a database that includes thousands of pre-recorded questions from a wide variety of industries/topics.

- Simply, click on an industry/topic and the system will display the questions underneath that particular section.
- Next, drag the question you would like to use into the Selected Questions section (Highlighted in Red below)

On the third page of the form you will be able to create a custom message that will be included in the email sent to your students. In addition, this is where you may either list the email addresses for your students (NOTE: email addresses need to be entered in the field with only one per line) It is also best practice to include your own email address to verify system messages are sent appropriately. Sending the assignment by email will help you maintain your roster, track student progress, and ensure automatic reminders are being sent from InterviewStream to your class.
