

## **VirtualEMS Frequently Asked Questions**

## Q) What is Setup Type and why do I have to specify one when looking for a room?


1) Every room has at least one standard Setup Type and many rooms can be configured in multiple ways. Each Setup Type can have a different minimum and maximum capacity. Here are the standard Setup Types:




Banquet – round tables & chairs




Boardroom – single permanent table surrounded by chairs




Classroom - tables & chairs




Conference – multiple tables used to form one large table



Double U – tables & chairs



Hollow Square – tables & chairs in a square shape



Theater – chairs in a row

2) Additional Setup Types:

Empty – no tables or chairs in the room To Be Determined – unsure at this time, but will complete a diagram at a later date

3) When you choose a Setup Type in VirtualEMS, you will only be presented with the rooms that have been configured with that Setup Type. *For example, if you choose Boardroom, you will only be presented with Taylor 303, 307, 311, Warren 403 or Festival Conference Room 5.*
