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Executive Summary

In its second year, the Advising Resource Collaboration (ARC) Network has continued progress toward building and shaping a valuable community of practice for all practitioners and advocates for advising at James Madison University. The 2022-2023 year included the continual work of building partnerships, assessing community needs, and defining the role of the ARC network – while also developing and implementing the inaugural Day of Community Conversations Advising Conference at JMU.

Most of this report provides details of the planning, implementation, and evaluation process of the conference. Based on our assessment of the data collected post-conference, in combination with reflection from the core planning team, we offer recommendations for future events as well as the continued growth of the ARC Network. We believe the recommendations in the report provide essential guidance as the ARC Network continues to provide support to the advising community and build connections with campus partners.
