The International Network of Universities (INU) is pleased to offer five awards of up to £1,700 to early researchers (who have completed their PhD within the past 5 years) to engage in research at another [INU member university](#).

About the Researcher Mobility Program

INU is committed to establishing multilateral research collaborations across INU network of universities.

To achieve this, the [Researcher Mobility Program](#) provides the opportunity for early researchers (who have completed their PhD within the past 5 years) to engage in research at another INU member university. The purpose of this program is to develop joint research initiatives between two INU member universities, with a view to further expand to multilateral research collaborations with other INU member universities in future.

Visits should be for 2-4 weeks and should form the basis for future collaboration between the two research centers.

The award

There are five awards of up to £1,700 available each year. The award contributes towards travel and living costs to facilitate the visit.

Deadline to apply

Wednesday 26th March 2025

Criteria

- Applicants must be employed as a researcher at an INU member university for at least 6 months, prior to the application.
- Applicants must be an 'early' researcher, having completed their PhD within the last 5 years.
- Successful applicants must be employed as faculty in research activity at an INU member university at the time of undertaking their researcher mobility visit.
- Applicants require a good level of English to undertake this program.

How to apply

Applicants are asked to provide the following documentation to be considered: (Templates and additional advice can be found on the INU website).

1. Application form
2. A statement of purpose
3. A planned schedule
4. Letter of Support from the home institution
5. Letter of Acceptance from the host institution
6. Curriculum Vitae (CV) / Resumé
7. Budget outlining the expected cost of the visit.
