Re: Confirmation of in-person/hybrid education at James Madison University

To whom it may concern,

This letter is to confirm that James Madison University (JMU), of Harrisonburg, VA, will hold a mix of in-person, hybrid and online courses for the spring 2021 semester, starting on January 19, 2021. JMU is not operating entirely online for the spring semester.

James Madison University continues to practice social distancing and follow recommended precautions to limit the spread of COVID-19, all departments, offices, and services remain fully operational. As of, October 23, 2020, the JMU administration confirmed their intention to resume on-campus operations for the spring through the use of health screenings, face mask requirements, comprehensive cleaning and disinfecting protocols, contact tracing strategies, and quarantine policies.
