



Advising Sheet for Minors who declared the Minor BEFORE 8/2024 (18 Credit Hours)

Core coursework (6 credit hours)

Complete two courses from among the following core courses.

- Core course options: ANTH 265, HIST 313, HUM 252/LAXC 252, LAXC 300, POSC 350, SPAN 308.

Electives (12 credit hours)

Complete four additional courses from electives either in the LAXC curriculum or approved by course directive (see website for elective course opportunities and email the LAXC faculty advisor for a course directive).

Interdisciplinarity requirement

Of the 18 credit hours you take, you must select courses in at least three different disciplines, and you should take no more than nine credit hours in any one discipline. Note interdisciplinary listings (i.e. LAXC, HUM, HON) typically count by the discipline of the instructor. Use this checklist to keep track of your elective distribution:
