- ∞ How will we discuss **grades**?

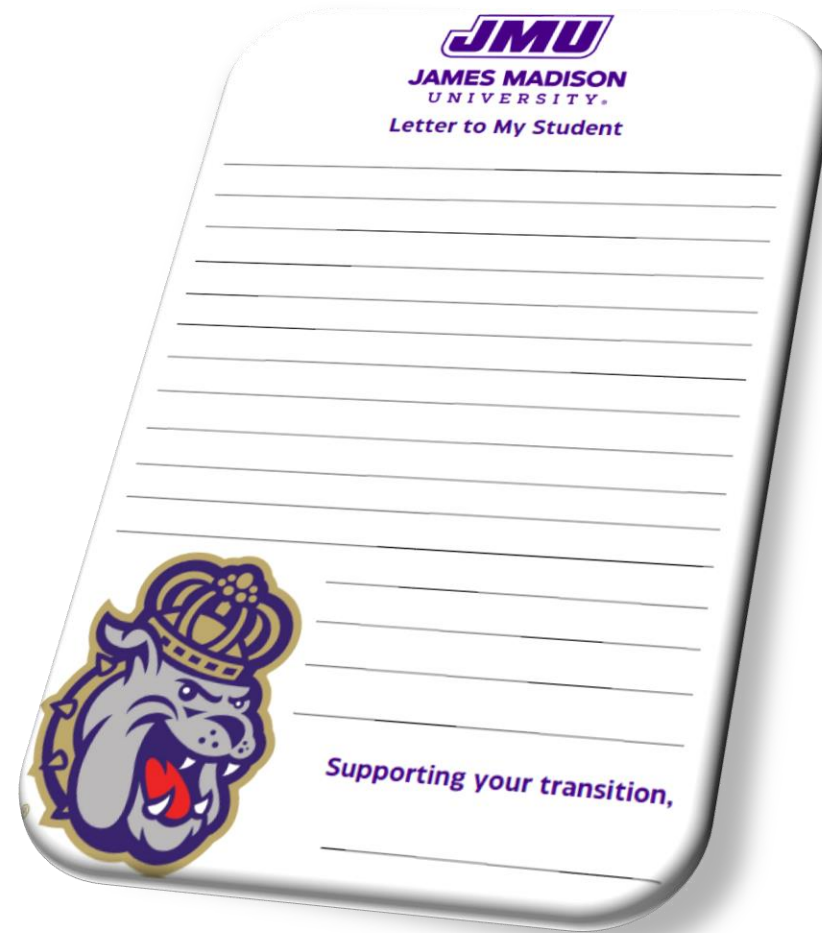


Making the Transition
