Go to CITI Program's website and click on "Log in":

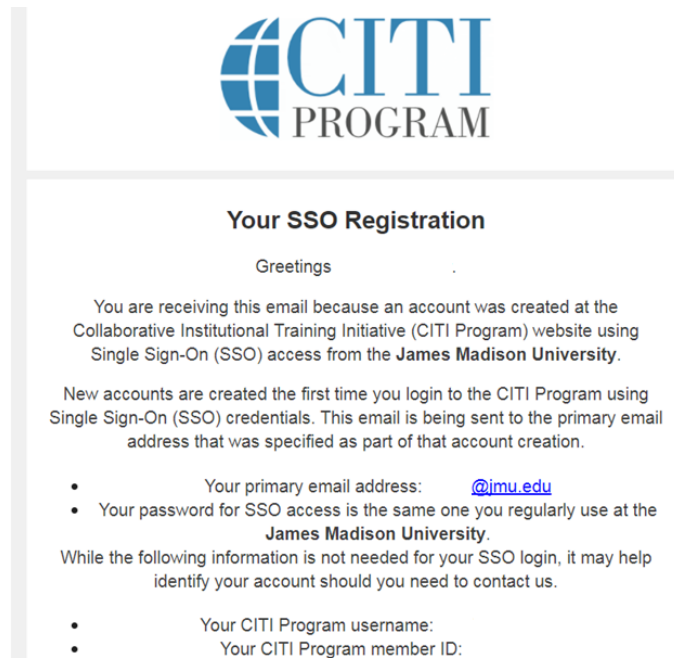

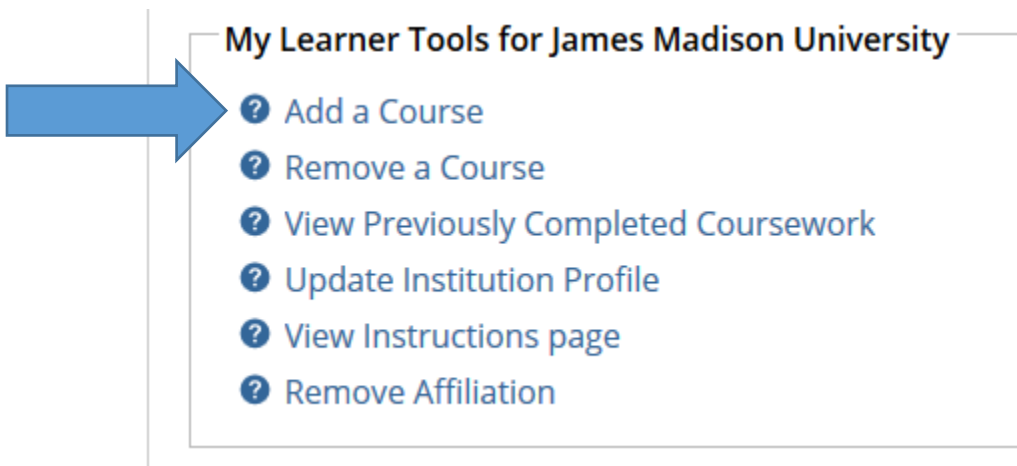

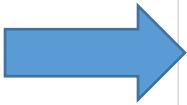
