Purpose of This Form
Per 2 CFR 200.331, JMU as the pass-through entity is responsible for making case-by-case determinations as to whether the entity receiving Federal funds is a <u>subrecipient</u> or a <u>contractor</u> . The former receives a <u>subaward</u> while the latter receives a procurement contract.
 <u>Subaward</u>: an award provided by a pass-through entity to a subrecipient for the subrecipient to contribute to the goals and objectives of the project by carrying out part of a Federal award received by the pass-through entity. It does not include payments to a contractor, beneficiary, or participant. <u>Subrecipient</u>: an entity that receives a subaward from a pass-through entity to carry out part of a Federal award. The term subrecipient does not include a beneficiary or participant. A subrecipient may also be a recipient of other Federal awards directly from a Federal agency. <u>Contractor</u>: an entity that receives a contract.
No single factor or any combination of factors is necessarily determinative. In making this determination, the substance of the relationship is more important than the form of the agreement. OSP will take the proposed subrecipient's scope of work (draft) into consideration and render the final decision.
